Book donations should be left under the tent on the table outside the Bookshed. Please note the notices re items that are not acceptable this year. Would you have an hour to help set up the Book Stall the morning of the Fayre, return excess books and tidy up at the end of the day, or take a shift during the Fayre? If so, please contact the Fayre organisers (details in the newsletter) Please note that the Fayre is the only occasion during the year when non-fiction books are available - grab them while you can! The Bookshed will reopen shortly after the Fayre with its normal collection of fiction for all ages.
