## Gospel Acclamation:

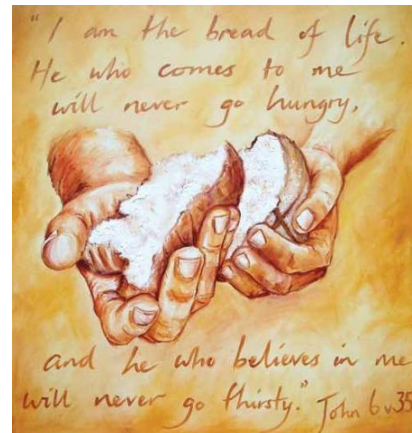
Alleluia, alleluia!
