











## St. Anthony's Parish

Important information for parishioners

Please read carefully and dispose of in an environmentally friendly manner

	<p>1. If you, or somebody in your household is <b>not feeling well</b>, please stay at home.</p> <p>2. You should <b>wear a face mask at all times</b> - before, during and after the Mass.</p>	<p>PLEASE</p>  <p>WEAR A MASK</p>
	<p>3. Please <b>follow the instructions</b> given by the ushers.</p> <p>4. <b>Avoid grouping together</b> with people who are not in your household bubble before, during and after the Mass.</p>	
	<p>5. For hygiene reasons, there are <b>no hymn/prayer books available</b>. (However, a selection of prayers may be found on the flip side of this info note).</p> <p>6. Please <b>do not shake hands</b> during the sign of peace (except for people in the same household).</p>	
	<p>7. <b>During communion</b>: please go to receive communion only when you are <b>instructed to by the ushers</b>. Always keep a <b>distance of 1.5m</b> between yourself and other persons when coming to receive communion.</p> <p>8. When receiving communion please <b>extend both your arms so that your hands</b> are under that of the Celebrant/Eucharistic minister. Please keep a distance of 1.5m between you and the Celebrant/Eucharistic minister. You should receive communion in silence.</p>	
	<p>9. If for any reason that you cannot walk up to receive communion <b>let one of the ushers know</b> and the Celebrant/Eucharistic minister will come to you.</p> <p>10. <b>There is no offertory collection</b>. If you would like to donate to the parish, a few collection boxes will be placed in the church grounds. ### **NICENE CREED**

### **APOSTLE'S CREED**
