BOTTLE STALL

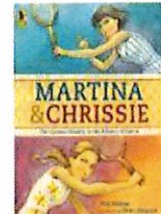
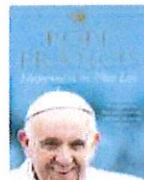
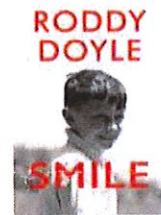
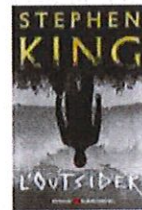
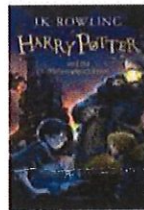
What about that 1975 bottle of Beaujolais Nouveau that's hiding in your cellar or your bottle of Chateaufneuf du Pape?
