Ministries & Other Faith Programmes

Adult Christian Faith Programme (RCIA) for anyone who wishes to explore the Christian Faith in the Catholic church or wishes to convert to Catholicism;

Alternative, Fond Jean Degive and St Vincent de Paul -long standing charities which the Parish has supported over many years;

Altar Servers from the age of 7 to help during masses;

The Angel Tree - our Christmas outreach to the poor and disadvantaged in Brussels;

Bible Reflection Home Group every Friday morning at the homes of our parishioners;

Catechetics classes for 1st Communion, the Old and New Testament, Liturgy, Reconciliation, Pre-Confirmation and Confirmation;

Charity Collections at certain times of the year to support various charities approved by the Parish Council;

Choirs - we have three choirs for the Weekend masses which give us wonderful music during the various masses at the Parish;

Church Linens - It is only with the help of parishioners that spotless linens are available for the masses;

Coffee and Doughnuts - a very important part of Sundays when parishioners can socialise and get to know each other;

Eucharistic Ministers and Lectors - this is an important part of the ministries of the church carried out by parishioners;

Finance Council - parishioners who assist the parish priest with respect to the supervision of all the material goods of the Parish;

Flower Arranging - a small group take turns to prepare the altar with flowers;

Growing in Faith Together (GIFT) - a weekly prayer, worship and discussion group;

HCPT - Lourdes Pilgrimage: A charity which organises pilgrimage holidays to Lourdes for handicapped and disadvantaged children that the Parish has been involved with for some years;

The Knights of St Thomas More - this is a Catholic men's fraternity supporting the mission of St Anthony's and the Catholic Church;

Pastoral Council - the Pastoral Council is a consultative body acting in an advisory capacity to the parish priest.

Stations of the Cross - During Lent, the Stations of the Cross take place on Friday evenings at 18:30.

Regular Parish Events

January: Wine Tasting hosted by the Knights of St Thomas More held towards the end of the month.

February, May & October: Pre-marriage Courses

Lent: *The one day concert.*

April/May: First Holy Communion and Confirmation (depending on the date of Easter).

June: St Anthony's Summer Fayre (normally the Sunday closest to the feast day).

August: The Good Samaritan collection, every Sunday

September: Meet 'n' Greet and Catechetics Registration

Sept-Oct: *Adult Spiritual Development course*

November: Pastoral Council AGM

Nov/Dec: Christmas Charity Fayre held the first weekend of Advent

December: Parish Carol Concert
